EU Supply Chain Laws - New Legal Landscape in the EU

CSRD (Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive)

CSRD (Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive)

Applies to:

Enforcement starts mid to late 2025

Enforcement starts mid to late 2025

Non-EU companies with significant EU turnover



Who is affected

Thresholds for Applicability



EU Companies

EU Companies: 1,000+ employees + €450M turnover

AND

€450M+ global turnover



Non-EU Companies

€450M+ EU turnover

OR

Tier 1 suppliers to EU companies



Who is affected in Azerbaijan

Exporters, Subcontractors & Tech providers

Business working directly or indirectly with the **EU market**



Examples

Textile factories exporting to European retailers Software companies providing digital tools to EU corporates Machinery part suppliers to German manufacturers (OEMs) Identify adverse impacts (human rights, environmental)

Prevent, mitigate and end such impacts

Establish grievance mechanisms

Monitor and report annually

Enforcement:
 Civil liability +
 administrative
 penalties

Key Legal Obligations (CSDDD)



Case Study – EU Retailer Pressures Azerbaijani Supplier

Scenario:

- Azerbaijani clothing manufacturer supplies a German fashion chain
- German client demands ESG audit, documentation of due diligence

Outcome:

- Supplier had no human rights policy or monitoring
- Lost contract

Lessons:

- Proactive legal due diligence is critical
- Develop compliance frameworks now





Azerbaijani Al Start-Up Selling to EU

Scenario

Baku-based startup sells chatbot tools to German SMEs

EU client asks: "Is it compliant with AI Act?"

Issues:

Lacked documentation, risk classification, user control

Advice:

Conduct risk assessment

Keep technical documentation

Consider CE marking for AI systems

DSA &
DMA ExtraTerritorial
Reach



DSA: Applies to digital platforms and intermediaries

Hosting obligations, content moderation



DMA: Targets large gatekeepers (Google, Amazon, etc.), but affects **ecosystems**



Non-compliance = large fines

Azerbaijani companies hosting EU
content or processing EU data must
comply



Data, Cybersecurity

GDPR + NIS2 = Data + Cyber Resilience





CSRD – ESG Reporting Starts Now



Applies to many EU companies from 2025



Non-EU suppliers affected indirectly



German clients will request:

- Carbon data
- Social & governance metrics
 Tip: Use ESG clauses in contracts
 and keep a compliance file



Greenwashing Risks

- Only claim what you can prove
- Use EU Taxonomy for ESG-aligned products/services
- Coordinate legal + marketing + compliance teams
